

## Job Description

### **Licensed Practical Nurse / LPN**

The **LPN** will work under the supervision of a registered nurse, the licensed practical nurse assumes responsibility and accountability for the application of the nursing process and the delivery of patient care in a outpatient medical clinic and /or an acute care setting. Consistently performs according to nursing standards and is accountable in managing patient care and assisting others in the management of patient care.

#### **Responsibilities include:**

Utilizes the nursing process to assess, plan, implement and evaluate patient care.

Performs focused interview to identify specific patients needs.

Assess signs and symptoms indicating physiologic and psychosocial changes in the patient's condition.

Collects, analyzes, and interprets data and information from health care members and documents actual and/or potential nursing diagnoses.

Be sensitive to cultural diversity issues of each patient.
