

Job Description

Registered Nurse/RN

The **RN** will work under the supervision of a Charge Nurse/Physician in the delivery of patient care in a acute care /clinic setting. The Registered nurse assumes responsibility and accountability for the application of the nursing process and the delivery of patient care in an outpatient medical clinic and/or an acute care setting. Consistently performs according to nursing standards and is accountable in managing patient care and assisting others in the management of patient care. Perform duties as assigned by the other clinical practitioner's.

Responsibilities include:

Utilizes the nursing process to assess, plan, implement and evaluate patient care.

Performs focused interview to identify specific patients needs.

Assess signs and symptoms indicating physiologic and psychosocial changes in the patient's condition.

Collects, analyzes, and interprets data and information from health care members and documents actual and/or potential nursing diagnoses.

Be sensitive to cultural diversity issues of each patient.

Qualifications include:

Current Licensed Registered Nurse (RN).

Full command, verbal and written, of the English language.

Current Health Statement/Physical.

Current PPD or Chest X-Ray.

Negative Criminal Background Check.

Negative Urine Drug Screen.

One to Two year's prior professional nursing experience preferred.

Current BLS card.

Current ACLS card if applicable to position.

Successful completion of the application process.
